Re: Prescribed Burn for Castle Hayne Park

(New Hanover County)— A prescribed burn of underbrush is planned for New Hanover County's Castle Hayne Park. County and NC Forest Service officials anticipate the burning to take place, weather conditions allowing, by mid-February.

Castle Hayne Park is a 30 acre recreational facility located off Parmele Road in the Castle Hayne community. (See attached maps) The exact date and time of the controlled burn will be announced as short-term weather forecasts permit officials to proceed. All efforts will be taken to notify nearby residents through news media, the New Hanover County website (www.nhcgov.com), New Hanover County Television and through the county's reverse 911 system.

During the burn, the park will be closed to the public.
