#### **New Hanover County Cells 2-6 Partial Closure County Bid No. 15-0212**

Notice of rebid – due to lack of sufficient bidders at the time and place of the bid opening on January 14, the project is being rebid. The mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held January 28, 2015 at 2:00 p.m. at the Environmental Management Administration Building, 3002 Highway 421 North, Wilmington, NC. Attendance at the Pre-Bid Meeting is mandatory for **ALL** potential bidders including those who attended the original Pre-bid meeting. The re-bid advertisement is included with this package.

**Bidders, please review the detail included herein for confirmation of the changes noted below.**

1. Specification 00100 – Instructions to Bidders, Article 3, 3.2 – The timeframe of the Prime Contractor having liner experience of 10 acres or more is changed from 10 to 15 years.
2. Specification 02550 Textile - is modified to direct the manufacturer to provide one quality control test series per 40,000 square feet of textile material. The tests to be performed are listed in the specification by table for the appropriate textile type.

## **INVITATION TO RE-BID**

### **NEW HANOVER COUNTY INVITATION TO SUBMIT PROPOSAL FOR CONSTRUCTION OF LANDFILL CELLS 2-6 PARTIAL CLOSURE**

New Hanover County will receive sealed proposals from qualified contractors for all labor and materials to complete the work in accordance with the "Specifications and Contract Documents" for New Hanover County Secure Landfill Cells 2-6 Partial Closure for New Hanover County, North Carolina. This is a rebid of this project.

The partial closure of approximately 10 acres of Cells 2-6 will include confirmation of depth of soil cover, site preparation, placement of the liner system, placement of the soil cover, installation of the gas management system, construction of the stormwater management structures, erosion control structures, grading, access roadway, and all incidentals necessary to complete the work as specified. The construction period will be 150 days from the notice to proceed to substantial completion and an additional 30 days to final completion. Common fill for the preparation of the intermediate cover for the landfill shall be supplied from an off-site borrow source. Topsoil shall be obtained from an off-site borrow source.

A MANDATORY pre-bid conference will be held on January 28, 2015 at 2:00 p.m. in the Environmental Management Administration Building, 3002 Highway 421 North, Wilmington, NC. Note that all bidders must attend the mandatory pre-bid meeting, including those who attended the first pre-bid meeting on 12/11/14.

Proposals will be received until 2:00 p.m. on February 25, 2015, by New Hanover County, in the Conference room at the New Hanover County Department of Environmental Management Administration Building, 3002 HWY 421 North, Wilmington, North Carolina 28401, at which time the proposals will be publicly opened and read in accordance with the provisions of law. The deadline time shall be established by the timepiece of New Hanover County's representative. No bids will be accepted after that time.

Bidders may purchase bidding documents (Contract Documents, Specifications, and Drawings) for \$185.00 per set from SCS Engineers, PC, 4041 Park Oaks Boulevard, Suite 100, Tampa, Florida, 33610-9510. The telephone number is 813.621.0080. Make checks payable to SCS Engineers. No refunds will be given.

A copy of the Specifications and Contract Documents can be reviewed at the New Hanover County Environmental Management Office, 3002 Highway 421 North, Wilmington, North Carolina 28401, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Please call for appointments.

Bidders must be licensed contractors in the State of North Carolina at the time proposals are submitted. Pursuant to N.C.G.S. S87-15, it will be necessary for contractors to show evidence of such license in the bid document.

No proposal for construction or repair work may be considered or accepted by said board or governing body unless at the time of its filing the same shall be accompanied by a deposit with said board or governing body of cash, or a cashier's check, or a certified check on some bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation in an amount equal to not less than five percent (5%) of the proposal. In lieu of making the cash deposit as above provided, such bidder may file a bid bond executed by a corporate surety licensed under the laws of North Carolina to execute such bonds, conditioned that the surety will upon demand forthwith make payment to the obligee upon said bond if the bidder fails to execute the contract in accordance with the bid bond. This deposit shall be retained if the successful bidder fails to

execute the contract within 10 days after the award or fails to give satisfactory surety as required herein.

Contractor will be required to comply with OSHA and all federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules and regulations that in any way affect the Work and will be required to review/endorse the County's Contractor Compliance Requirements in Section 01910. Bidders will be required to submit a Qualification Questionnaire located in Section 00300 as part of their bid to demonstrate qualifications to perform the Work.

The bidder shall make good faith efforts, as defined in the bid specifications, to subcontract 10% of the dollar value of the single prime contract to businesses owned and controlled by minorities. Individuals who are rebuttably presumed to be minorities include women, Black Americans, Hispanic Americans, Native Americans, Asian-Pacific Americans, and Asian-Indian Americans. Bidders are required to submit, along with the bid, information concerning minority business enterprises which will participate in the contract. The information will include: (1) name and address of each minority firm; (2) description of the work to be performed by each minority firm named; and (3) the dollar value of the work to be performed by each firm named. Bidders are required to submit along with the bid, specific documentation demonstrating that they made good faith efforts to meet established goals. All prime bidders on this project must be pre-qualified in accordance with New Hanover County's Pre-qualification Ordinance, in order to bid. Bids will not be opened unless the bidder is pre-qualified.
