

This addendum is issued regarding questions received for “RFB # 16-0107-Construction & Demolition Waste and Vegetative Waste Grinding & Marketing” and is hereby made a part of said Request for Bids to the same extent as though it were originally therein.

1. Who is the current contractor and what is the current grinding price?
 - **Wood grinding (clean, sorted wood waste) : Diversified Biomass, Inc., dba American Property Experts. \$9.65/ton for contract that expired 6/30/15. Interim agreement in place for temporary grinding of wood waste at \$12.43/ton.**
 - **Vegetative Waste/Yard Debris grinding: Diversified Biomass, Inc., dba American Property Experts. \$12.43/ton**
2. Does the current grinding price include the hauling of the mulch? The contract for wood grinding that expired 6/30/15, based upon the last bid award, did include the hauling of the material.
3. Where is the mulch currently being hauled to? **Area biomass to energy plants.**
4. What is the current pay for the hauling of the sheet rock? **\$29.75/ton.**
5. Can you give an example of hauling sheetrock with a backhaul? **Sheetrock hauled to Class A compost facility, truck unloaded at Class A compost facility, truck re-loaded with cured compost at Class A compost facility, compost load hauled back to landfill for use at landfill.**
6. Is there any kind of clause for a fuel adjustment throughout the contract? The bidder will have the option to submit an alternate per-unit price based on a fuel surcharge using the US DOE formula for On-Highway Diesel – All Types for the Lower Atlantic (PADD 1C) area.

7. Can you clarify if the payment is based on the incoming tonnage or the outgoing tonnage? Pg. 11 and 12. Please clarify. **Payment based on outgoing tonnage weighed across landfill certified scales.**
8. At the site visit it was said that the vegetative debris mulch would be kept onsite for the landfill use. Can you confirm this? **Yes, vegetative waste chips remain at landfill.**
9. If the vegetative debris mulch is kept onsite then what will payment be based on? Inbound vegetative waste is weighed across certified scales. **Inbound weight tonnages are stored in a computer software system that is used for reporting. The total tonnage received from the end of one grinding event to the completion of the next grinding event will be used as the basis of payment in \$/ton.**
10. Is there a specific screen requirement? **To be determined by Contractor negotiation with requirements of Class A compost facility.**

NOTE:

Due to the delay in getting responses out to bidders, the deadline for receipt of bids is being extended from Tuesday, September 29, 2015 to **Tuesday, October 13, 2015 at 3:00 pm. The location is still 230 Government Center Drive, Suite 165, Wilmington, NC 28403 (Opening to be held in Finance Conference Room 500).**
