This addendum is issued regarding Questions received for “RFB # 16-0107R-Rebid C & D and Vegetative Waste Grinding” and is hereby made a part of said Request for Bids to the same extent as though it were originally therein.

Question 1. In order to process the drywall for agricultural use the paper has to be removed. The paper is equivalent to about 8% of the drywall by weight, the paper is non-recyclable due to the residual gypsum attached. Will there be a charge to dispose of the paper?

We recommend reaching out to livestock operations to see whether or not they may be interested in using the paper for bedding. However, if it is necessary to dispose of the paper, there will be no charge for disposal of residue paper associated with processing gypsum wallboard from material generated at the NHC landfill.

Question 2. Can we process the drywall at the landfill?

Material can be processed at the NHC landfill if appropriate dust suppression measures are taken and proper employee personal protective equipment is in use.
