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**This addendum is issued to respond to an additional question received in response to the County's "RFB # 17-0153- IN VESSEL COMPOSTING EQUIPMENT" and is hereby made a part of said Request for Bids to the same extent as though it were originally therein. Question #13 below was submitted prior to the deadline for bidder questions, but was inadvertently left off of Addendum #1.**

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13. The RFB requires a feed conveyor and a discharge conveyor, which suggests that the County is considering a drum-type compost system. However, there are other in-vessel/enclosed compost systems that don't necessarily need/require a feed conveyor and a discharge conveyor. These other systems usually rely on a front-end loader to feed and unload the compost system. Will the County accept compost systems other than drum-type compost systems? Can the feed conveyor and discharge conveyor be deleted from the scope, if not needed for the specific compost system?

**ANSWER: Yes, an alternate bid may be submitted, provided the alternate system being bid is an in-vessel compost system. Please clearly mark the bid as an "ALTERNATE BID."**
