Short stack and tall stack rain barrels are available for purchase and pick up on the second Thursday of each month at the West entrance of New Hanover County's Government Center.

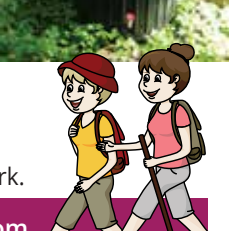

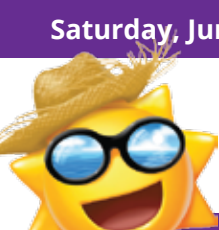
