Art in the Arboretum

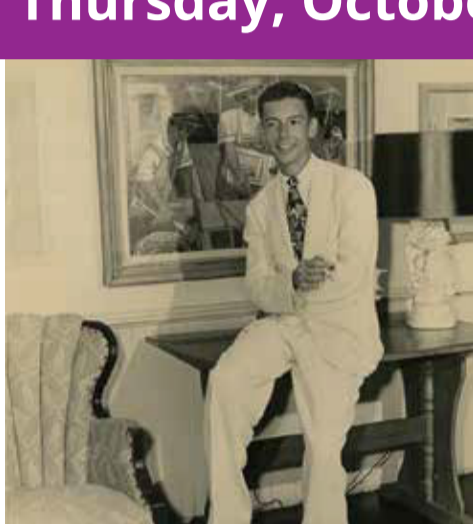

Reflections on Claude 7pm



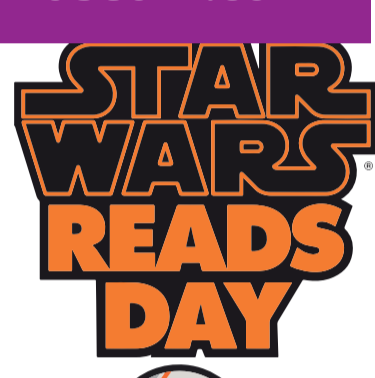
