DISCLAIMER: Any work done without the required permit(s) or done by using this permit for work outside the scope of this permit violates the North Carolina State Building Code and is subject to the fees and (or) fines prescribed in the Building Safety Fee Schedule and (or) the New Hanover County Code of Ordinances.

FOR PROJECTS IN UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF NEW HANOVER COUNTY: New Hanover County prohibits occupying a new building or part thereof before issuing a Certificate of Occupancy. And without further notice, occupying a building before an issued Certificate of Occupancy subjects the building owner to the penalties outlined in the New Hanover County Unified Development Ordinance Section 12.4. The penalties set forth include but are not limited to civil penalties assessed at the rate of \$100 for the first day, \$200 for the second day, and \$300 for each subsequent day that the violation persists.

FOR PROJECTS LOCATED IN OTHER ZONING JURISDICTIONS WITHIN NEW HANOVER COUNTY: Without further notice, these may also subject the building owner to similar penalties for the violations stated above, and additional penalties otherwise authorized by law.

FURTHERMORE, THE NORTH CAROLINA GENERAL STATUTES § 160D -1116 PROVIDES: No new building or part thereof may be occupied, no addition or enlargement of an existing building may be occupied, and no existing building that has been altered or moved may be occupied, until the inspection department has issued a certificate of compliance. Also, any person "who owns, leases, or controls a building and occupies or allows the occupancy of the building or a part of the building before a certificate of compliance or temporary certificate of occupancy has been issued ... is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor."
